# MEMBERSHIP

## What Is Expected of Me as a Member?

At FOTP, we never ask our members to do more than the Bible clearly teaches. We only expect our members to do what the Bible expects every Christian to do. The difference between 'attenders' and 'members' can be summed up in one word: **commitment**.

These responsibilities are spelled out in the Membership Commitment:

Having received Christ as my Lord and Savior and been baptized, and being in agreement with the church's purpose, beliefs, strategy, and structure, I now feel led by the Holy Spirit to unite with FOTP. In doing so, I commit myself to God and to the other members to do the following:

**1. I Will Protect the Unity of My Church** | by acting in love toward, and pursuing healthy relationships with other members; by refusing to gossip; by supporting and following the leaders.

Romans 15:5-6 | *<sup>5</sup>May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup>so that with one heart and mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.*

Hebrews 13:17 | *<sup>17</sup>Obey your leaders and submit to their authority. They keep watch over you as men who must give an account. Obey them so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no advantage to you.*

**2. I Will Share the Responsibility of My Church** | by praying for her growth; by investing in and inviting the unchurched; by warmly welcoming those who visit.

Luke 14:23 | *<sup>23</sup>Then the master told his servant, "Go out to the roads and country lanes and make them come in, so that my house will be full."*

**3. I Will Serve in the Ministry of My Church** | by volunteering where needed; by pursuing LifeGroups and LifeQuest; by discovering & developing my gifts and talents.

Philippians 2:4 | *<sup>4</sup>Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. <sup>5</sup>Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus:*

**4. I Will Support the Testimony of My Church** | by attending faithfully; by living a Godly life; by giving regularly.

Hebrews 10:25 | *"Let us not give up the habit of meeting together. . . but let us encourage one another."*

Leviticus 27:30 | *"A tenth of all you produce is the Lord's, and it is holy."*
